2020-2021 COVID-19 HEALTH GUIDELINES

Based on current recommendations from the CDC and the State of Indiana Health Department, Trinity Learning Ministry has implemented these updated health guidelines for the 2020-2021 school year.

Students should not attend school if:

- They are running a fever over 100°
- They have any of the following COVID-19 related symptoms:
 - cough
 - shortness of breath
 - fatigue
 - muscle or body aches
 - headache
 - loss of taste or smell
 - sore throat
 - congestion or runny nose
 - nausea or vomiting
 - diarrhea
- ANY person in the home has a fever or COVID-19 related symptoms. This includes family members in any home where the child spends a significant amount of time, such as the home of another parent, grandparents, or other caregivers.

Students are required to stay home until the affected person:

- is fever free for at least 72 hours (3 days) without being given fever reducing medication
- has had improvement in their symptoms

AND at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
